- When fighting, one competitor will wear a red ribbon tied to his belt in the back and the other only the original belt.
- Hands and feet nails must be cut off. Competitors may not wear metallic objects on them during the competition.
- It is not allowed to use protective clothing, bandages or any other protection except those set out previously in place and approved by the doctor of the competition and always after the second round of bouts.

#### **CADETS CATEGORY**

#### AT THE END OF THE BOUT WAZARIS WILL BE SUMMED.

Every time that a jodan technique is correctly executed a wazaari will be awarded. If other permitted techniques are executed and the opponent stands or loses his/her desire of fighting for more than 3 seconds, a half point (Wazaari) will be given. If no points have been scored during the bout, judges will decide the winner according with the techniques executed by each participant and the control of the fight. Fouls will be taken into account.

#### **JUVENILE /SUB 21 / SENIOR CATEGORY**

If one of the competitors achives an Ippon, will be declared as the winner. If no Ippon is scored then the contestant who has obtained more Waza-ari will win. If no points are scored then the judges will decide. Fouls will be taken into account. TWO WAZAARI (HALF) POINTS GIVE IN TOTAL CLEAR VICTORY (AWAZATE IPPON GACHI).

### COACH

Coaches must arrive one hour before the start of the competition. In order to give and receive the necessary information to ensure a correct development of the competition.

A maximum number of 4 coaches can be registered.

Coaches will take care at all times of the protective equipment of the competitors in all categories.

Coaches must be in sportswear and must carry the identification which will be handled during the weighing. It is compulsory that coaches are registered along with the competitors and referees; otherwise they will not be allowed to access the competition area.

The Coach must keep his composure at all times, without shouting or making a fuss, otherwise he shall be excluded from the competition and the bout will count as lost.

There will be a referee commission to address the doubts. This commission will take or vary the arbitration decision.

### **COMPETITORS**

Competitors must keep composture at all times, both on and off the tatami. Competitors must be in the competition area enabled. Otherwise, they will be excluded from the competition. The competitor will be called, if he is not in the competition area, he will be called again after 1 minute. If after this minute the competitor does not show up he will be disqualified.

All competitors over 18 years old, who compete in kumite must deliver a signed letter during the weighing, or via e-mail, (provided by the organization), exempting the organization in case of injuries resulting the competition.

All under age competitors, who compete must deliver a signed letter by the legal tutor of their parents during the weighing, or via e-mail, (provided by the

organization), exempting the organization in case of injuries resulting the competition.

In addition, competitors from IKO MATSUSHIMA SPAIN will have to present the updated license for 2016. Those who do not present such documentation will not be allowed to take part in the championship.

The Organization of the championship will not be in any way responsible for any injuries or accidents that may occur during the course of the competition. Each competitor must have a sports insurance that covers any injuries that may occur during the competition.

### REFEREES

Referees must arrive one hour before the start of the competition. In order to give and receive the necessary information to ensure a correct development of the competition.

A minimum number of 2 referees per dojo must be registered. If it was not possible, a registry fee should be paid by each competitor. Referees must be uniformed in a DARK BLUE suit, DARK BLUE shirt and DARK BLUE tie.

During the parade referees will wear jacket and shoes. They will take of their shoes while in the tatami area.

In greetings to the referees and judges mawate be held behind and to the right.

#### **PUBLIC**

Be polite at all times.

If someone rebukes the referee / coach / competitors / competition staff or any other person, he/she will be expelled from the competition, without any refund of the entry fee.

The dojo might be disqualified for misbehavior by the public.

Video recordings and photographs will be taken from the stands. No entry will be allowed in the competition area for people who do not carry official accreditation.

## **KATA GENERAL RULES:**

- 1-Evaluating the kata performed the following criteria has to be considered:
- Performance of the kata with sufficient competence and clear understanding of the kata.
- Appropriate focus of attention, the right use of strength, good balance and good respiration.
- 2- Three katas will be performed in a row, each of them in one of the enabled tatamis.
- 3-In the first tatami the score values will be between 5 and 7, in the second tatami between 6 and 8, y and in the last tatami between 7 and 9.

- 4- The katas to be performed will be the ones internationally recognized by different Kyokushin organizations.
- 5-There will be 3 referees from different dojos in each tatami.
- 6- The highest and the lowest scores will not be taken into account when calculating the mean value.
- 7-If there is a drawn, the lowest values obtained will be included in the final punctuation (starting with the values obtained in tatami n° 1)
- 7-The competitor will handle a paper sheet in each tatami which specifies the name of the kata to be performed. Punctuation will be written down in this paper sheet. After the performance the competitor must leave the document in the judges table.
- 8-After all competitors of the category have presented their katas in the three tatamis, prizes will be awarded. There will be first, second and third places.
